

Creating Photo CDs or DVDs with ACDSee Photomanager

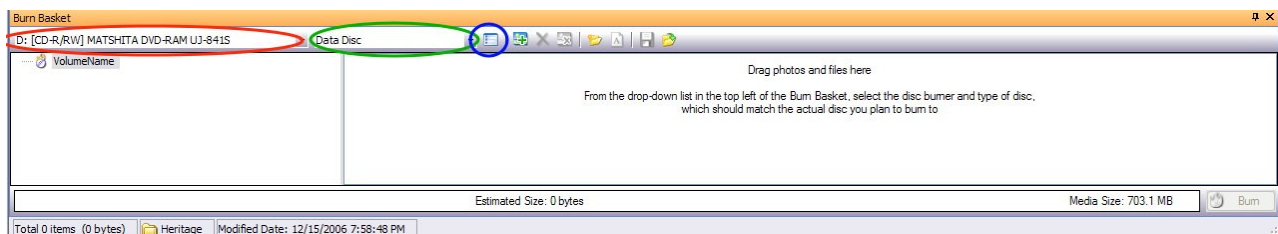
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With the Burn Basket, you can organize, arrange, and store your photos and digital kits until you are ready to burn them to a disc. Depending on the disc format you choose, you can create your own folders or have the Burn Basket create the folder structure automatically.

To create a CD or DVD:

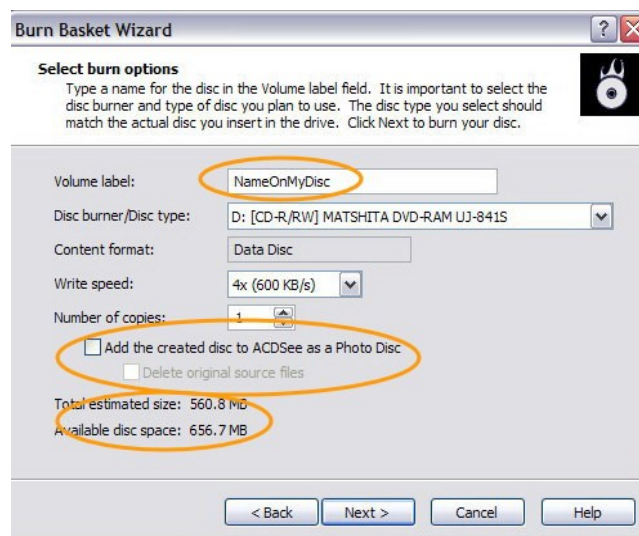
1. To open the Burn Basket pane, do one of the following:
2. Click **View | Burn Basket**.



3. Click **Create | Create CD or DVD**.
2. In the Burn Basket, in the first drop-down menu (Red circled field in screenshot), select CD or DVD whichever one you plan on making.
3. In the second drop-down list (Green circled field in screenshot), select **Data Disc**: creates a standard CD or DVD, on which you can create a folder structure and store photos and files of any type. Click the **Format Options** button to specify whether you want to include any ACDSee database information associated with your files.
4. Click on the next button (Blue circled field in screenshot), and verify the box is checked.
5. You can use the left side of the Burn Basket to create a folder structure to organize the photos and files on the disc. To create a new folder, right-click the name of a folder and select **New Folder** from the shortcut menu. Type a name for the new folder and then press **Enter**.
6. To add photos, digital kits, or other files to your disc, drag the thumbnails from above to the Burn Basket, or select the files you want to add and then click **Edit | Add to Burn Basket**, or pull an entire folder from above.
While adding make sure that the line at the bottom stays in the green or yellow. Once it starts turning red, you are close to filling the disc size that you have chosen.
4. When you are ready to create your disc, click **Burn**.



- Click Next



- Enter in the name of the disc. If you use these as Photo Disc's later in ACDSee it is a good idea to make a good name. If it's all one Designer's, say DesignersName1 or all from one store StoreName2, etc.
- If you are planning on using it as Photo Disc that works in ACDSee click the box **Add the created disc to ACDSee as a Photo Disc**
- If you are planning on only having that kit on your PhotoDisc and don't want it on your hard drive anymore, click **Delete original source files**.
- Verify that Total estimated size is less than Available Disk Space. **If it is not, go back and remove some files from your burn basket. It will not fit on the chosen media and will fail.**
- Click **Next** and it will start burning

TIP 1: Once you are comfortable with this process, you can skip the wizard by clicking on the box on the first window that comes up after you click burn.

TIP 2: You can change the Volume Name by right clicking on it in the Burn Basket and choosing **Rename**.
